Kabeldiefstal 'n kopseer

'Kabeldiefstal is 'n groot probleem vir die metro want dit vat lank vir die kabels om weer herstel te word omdat daar soveel gevalle is.'

Kabeldiefstal in die Moot is besig om 'n knaende probleem vir owerhede en sekuriteitsmaatskappy te word.

"Daar gaan feitlik nie 'n week verby wat daar nie kabels gesteel word nie," vertel Reinhard Raschke van MCS Sekuriteit.

"Ek sal sê daar is omrent twee tot drie gevallen per week."

Raschke sê die woonbuurte wat die meeste geaffekteer word deur dié misdaad was East Lynne en Möregloed.

"Die Rietfontein-gebied word ook geteiken tussen 22e en 24e Laan in Louis Trichardtstraat," sê hy.

"Dit raak regtig 'n groot probleem in ons gebied."

Hy sê dit was belangrik vir inwoners om nie die misdadigers te konfronteer nie.

"Net voor die nasionale inperking was 'n inwoner geskiet in Wonderboom-Suid toe hy gaan onderzoek instel by 'n kabeldiefstal gevallen," sê hy.

Raschke verwys na 'n geval in Maart toe inwoner, Francois Lubbe in sy eie oprit geskiet is.

Tydens 'n vorige onderhoud met *Rekord* het Lubbe verduidelik dat sy vrou wakker gemaak is deur 'n harde geluid wat van buiten gekom het.

"Sy het my wakker gemaak en vir my gesê dat sy dink dat misdadigers weer kabels buite gesteel het," het hy voorheen vertel.

Volgens hom het hy onmiddellik opgestaan, die huissleutels gegryp en na buite gegaan.

"Toe ek in die oprit staan, draai ek om en sê vir my vrou om terug te staan," het hy gesê.

"Die oomblik toe ek omdraai om my vrou te laat terugstaan, het ek 'n geweerskoot gehoor en ek het gevallen."

Hy sê hy was in sy onderrug getref.

Raschke sê kabeldiewe was soms gewapen.

"Moet hulle asseblief nooit konfronteer nie – jy en jou familie se veiligheid kom eerste," sê hy.

"Laat weet eerder vir jou plaaslike sekuriteitsmaatskappy, polisie en metropolisie."

Tesame met kabeldiefstal, is die diefstal van hekmotors ook besig om toe te neem.

"Dit is baie vreemd datanneer kabeldiefstal hoog is, is hekmotordiefstal ook hoog," sê hy.

"Dis amper asof hierdie twee misdade hand aan hand loop."

Raschke sê die afgelope naweek was daar sewe gevallen van hekmotordiefstal in Queenswood en Kilnerpark.

Voormalige raadslid Elmarie Linde sê in die metro se streek 3 was daar vir die afgelope twee weke elke aand 'n geval van kabeldiefstal.

"Die gewildste tye vir hierdie misdaad is gewoonlik tussen 02:00 en 05:00 in die oggende," sê sy.

"So dit is belangrik dat inwoners paraat moet wees tydens daardie tye."

"As die honde begin blaf in daardie tyd, is die kans goed dat daar kabeldiewe aan die werk is."

Linde sê kabeldiewe gebruik gewoonlik 'n boutsnyer (bolt cutter) en klim teen die paal op.

"Hulle werk gewoonlik in groepe van vier

tot agt, afhangende van hoeveel pale hulle steel."

Sy sê somtyds lyk dit soos amptelike Tshwane metro voertuie wat werk doen.

"Wat dan gebeur is die elektrisiteit is aan en dan sodra die voertuig weg is, is die elektrisiteit af," sê sy.

"Dit beteken dat dit mense is wat onder die vaandel van die metro gaan werk het en kabels gaan steel het."

Sy sê die belangrikste met só 'n geval is dat inwoners op die uitkyk moet wees hiervoor.

"Maar moet hulle egter nie net sommer konfronteer nie," sê sy.

"Inwoners kan as daar opgemerk word dat hulle aan die pale peuter belangrike besonderhede kry, soos die voertuig se registrasienommer.

"Dan as die krag af gaan sodra hulle weg is, kan inwoners weet dat dit 'n geval van kabeldiefstal was."

Linde het ook na Lubbe verwys en inwoners ook gewaarsku om versigtig te wees.

"Daar was ook al gevallen waar die voertuig 'n entjie weg geparkeer staan en dan sodra die kabel geknip is, vlug hulle in die voertuig," sê sy.

Sy sê inwoners moet onmiddellik die metropolisie laat weet indien daar 'n kabeldiefstal gevallen was.

"Kabeldiefstal is 'n groot probleem vir die metro want dit vat lank vir die kabels om weer herstel te word omdat daar soveel gevallen is," sê sy.

"Daar werk steeds 'n beperkte span as gevolg van die inperking."

Sy sê inwoners het verlede week tot 48 uur gewag vir krag om herstel te word as gevolg van kabeldiefstal.

Nuwe hoof by Moot-skool

Antoinette Dowd is die eerste vrou skoolhoof in die geskiedenis van HTS John Vorster.

'n Hoërskool in die Moot het vir die eerste keer in sy geskiedenis 'n vrou wat aan die stuur van sake staan.

Antoinette Dowd is die eerste vrou skoolhoof in die geskiedenis van HTS John Vorster, sê Nicollette Vermaak van die bemarkingspan van die skool.

"Sy is 'n dame van formaat," sê sy.

Volgens Vermaak was Dowd vir die afgelope 27 jaar deel van die John Vorster-span.

"Sy is iemand met John Vorster-bloed wat deur haar are vloeい en sy glo vas in haar Skepper," sê sy.

"Daarom weet ons dat sy 'n uitstekende skoolhoof sal wees.

"Mag HTS John Vorster van krag tot krag gaan en onder haar leiding nuwe opwindende hoogtes bereik!"

Dowd is in Mei as die nuwe skoolhoof aangekondig en het in haar posisie begin toe skole weer in Junie heropen het.

"Dit voel vir my 'n reg'. Ek is vandat ek begin skoolhou het nog al die jare by tegniese hoërskole," vertel Dowd.

"Ek weet wat die waarde van so 'n studierigting is en kan met gesag daaroor praat.

"Vir my gaan dit nie daaroor dat dit 'n man of 'n vrouw in die pos is nie, solank daardie persoon 'n passie vir die skool en sy personeel en kinders het asook 'n visie van waarnatoe mens met die skool wil beweeg."

Dowd sê dit is vir haar belangrik dat die publiek daar buite besef dat daar in 'n tegnologiese skool geleenthede vir alle leerders is.

"Die persepsie dat slegs leerders wat sogenaamd 'met hulle hande wil werk' hier hoort moet hokgeslaan word," sê sy.

"Die tegnologiese studierigting vereis hoe intellektuele vermoëns siende dat wiskunde en fisiese wetenskappe verpligte vakke by die skool is en nie bloot

keusevakke nie. Dit is ook ondersteunende vakke vir die tegnologievakke."

Sy verduidelik dat bo en behalwe die tegnologieverwante studierigtings soos ingenieurs, argitekte, bourekenaars en vele meer, het die skool ook al sy kwota mediese dokters, predikante, mense in die regsveld en vele ander opgelewer.

"Hier is jy nie beperk met 'n rigting waarin jy wil gaan studeer nie," sê sy.

"Die verpligte vakke wiskunde en fisiese wetenskappe maak alle deure oop. En hierdie boodskap is wat ons wil uitstuur na die gemeenskap."

Dowd, wat ook in die Moot woon, het in April 1993 by die skool begin as die Engelse departementshoof.

"Daarna is ek bevorder tot interne adjunkhoof en daarna was ek na senior adjunkhoof verplaas," sê sy.

Sy het begin skoolhou as 'n jong eerstejaar juffrou by die HTS

"Dit was wonderlike jare in my onderwysloopbaan," sê sy.

"Behalwe vir akademie, was ek ook betrokke as landloop- en sagtebal-organiseerde en het ek tennis en atletiek afgerig."

Dowd sê haar groot liefde lê by leterontwikkeling, wat sy tot nou toe nog by betrokke is.

"By HTS Pretoria Tuine is my grondslag as onderwyser gelê - mens was net eenvoudig by alles betrokke," sê sy.

"Van my mooiste herinneringe en blywendste vrienksappe kom uit hierdie tydperk. 'n Stukkie van my hart sal altyd aan my 'eerste skool' behoort."

Sy sê haar grootste vreugde in die onderwys was om die groei en ontwikkeling in die kinders te sien.

"Hoe hulle 'mens' word wanneer hulle hul doel en rigting besef," sê sy.

"Om daardie kern binne in 'n kind aan te raak en vir hom of haar hoop te gee.

"Ons kinders leef onder geweldige druk en soms met groot trauma in hulle lewe. Skool is vir party van hulle die enigste plek waar hulle veilig voel, waar hulle aanvaarding kry," sê sy.

"Dis vir my belangrik dat HTS John Vorster daardie hawe vir kinders is - 'n plek waar hulle binne grense hulself kan ontdek, kan groei en ontwikkel om een dag sy/haar plek in die samelewning vol te staan."

Dowd sê sy is geseënd om 'n werk te kan doen wat ook haar passie is.

"Toenterjare was die enigste manier vir my om te kon studeer om 'n onderwysbeurs te kry," sê sy.

"Iemand het toe vir my gesê, 'Antoinette, jy sal nooit 'n juffrou kan wees nie want jy praat heeltemal te sag'. Wat 'n groot genade dat dit toe nie of ek sag of hard kon praat wat bepaal het of ek my roeping gevind het of nie! Die Here het my voorwaar geseen."

Camera project will be expanding soon

A community safety initiative now consists of 398 CCTV cameras, 170 of which are placed in the streets of Waverley.

"However, we plan to expand this project to cover more areas in the area," said Reinhard Raschke, one of the owners at MCS Security, the company which started the camera project 13 years ago.

"Neighbourhoods like Queenswood, Kilnerpark, Capital Park, Mayville and Silverton are all part of our future planning."

He said the cameras, all funded by residents, were placed at strategic spots throughout the area.

"We monitor these cameras in our control room," he said.

He said, however, that they needed residents to assist them to be able to achieve this.

"If we work together, we will be able to successfully drive the criminals from our streets," he said.

Raschke said during the day, the cameras only monitored the area.

"During the night is when we truly see how these cameras help to combat crime," he said.

"The cameras have motion sensors and during the night, if it picks up any movement, a screen will pop up in the control room with an alarm."

He said, depending on the situation, their security officers could act accordingly.

"Most of the time, we manage to catch the criminals before they manage to enter a targeted property," he said.

He said the cameras were also able to pick up a vehicle's registration number.

"If the police are looking for a suspicious vehicle and they only have a section of the registration number, we are able to type in those letters on our database and easily able to find the vehicle," he said.

Raschke said the project has had many successes since it was started.

"If you look closely where there are cameras placed, crime is at a minimum," he said.

He referred to the increase of cable theft as an example.

"Waverley has not been targeted by this crime, while East Lynne, Môreglood and Rietfontein have been targeted several times," he said.

MCS security is operational in areas from East Lynne to Wonderboom South.

"Because our area is so small, we are more involved with the community. We know what their needs are and often tackle similar community initiatives with the CPF, police and other organisations."

Raschke said the project highlighted the importance of technology in fighting crime.

Heartbreak as Covid-19 mom loses baby

A woman, who tested positive for Covid-19 earlier this month, was informed last week, that she has lost her baby after contracting the virus.

"Her unborn baby died during her early days in hospital, but doctors advised us to not tell her because it could affect her recovery," father of Marzanne Lennox, Skip Scheepers said.

"She was informed of her baby's death last Tuesday morning."

Scheepers said his daughter underwent a procedure that very same day, to have her unborn baby removed.

"The procedure was successful," he said.

He said his daughter was back in ICU, where she would be further treated.

This week, Scheepers said that his daughter was making a positive recovery.

"Doctors are considering to remove her from the ventilator, but that all depends on her blood level reading results and the amount of oxygen in her blood," he said.

"An oxygen tube has been placed in her throat and doctors are now teaching her to properly breathe through it. Until it's removed, she won't be able to speak."

Scheepers said Lennox had a blood transfusion on Saturday.

He said Lennox was communicating to them through WhatsApp, adding that she remained positive.

"We remain positive and keep on praying that she will make a full recovery," he said.

Scheepers said they did not know when she would be released from hospital.

He said that he also wanted to use the opportunity to create awareness about the virus, especially among women who were pregnant.

"If there is one thing I can say to the community, it is this – please wear your mask, regularly wash your hands and stay away from other people," he said.

He also said that people should get Vitamin C, in the form of Vitamin supplements or fruits.

"Vitamin C improves your immune system," he said.

"Zinc is also very important."

Tuesday, three weeks ago, Lennox was still the example of a healthy young woman.

Scheepers previously explained that his daughter, who stayed in Midrand, did not show any of the main symptoms of the virus.

"For her, it started as a common blocked nose," he said.

"She was placed on a light antibiotic and a week later she did not show any symptoms of the virus."

By Monday two weeks ago, Lennox's condition worsened and she was also short of breath, Scheepers said.

"I told my wife that she was not looking well and she took her to hospital, where she was treated for the virus and placed on the ventilator," he said.

"She was also tested for the virus, of which she later tested positive."

Scheepers said they have received support from all around the world.

"People we do not even know, are supporting us and praying for our family," he said.

"We appreciate the support so much."


Ongelukkig het Covid-19 intussen 'n stok in die projek se wiel gesteek in meer as een manier.



'Prodigal son' could end career with Bulls

Three more names have been announced by the Bulls' management team as part of the exodus of players who will not be part of the new Jake White era at Loftus Versfeld.

Shortly after the news broke that the Bulls' captain, Burger Odendaal, will be leaving Loftus Versfeld to join the Lions, it also became known that three other regular faces in the SuperRugby team are no longer on the Blue Bulls Company's payroll.

The Bulls confirmed that prop Wiehahn Herbst, hooker Jaco Visagie and loose forward Abongile Nonkontwana will all leave Loftus Versfeld.

Like Odendaal, Herbst and Visagie will join the Bulls' neighbours across the Jukskei River, the Lions.

Although it is speculated that Nonkontwana is considering an offer from Griquas, nothing has yet been confirmed from Kimberley or Pretoria.

Herbst joined the Bulls after the 2018 season and spent a year and a half in the colours of the Bulls where his experience assisted immensely on the field and also in the grooming of some of the younger front row crop.

Visagie made his first-class debut in 2013's Vodacom Cup and went on to representing the franchise at all levels including u.19, u.21, Currie Cup and SuperRugby.

He earned his 50th cap for the Bulls against the Blues earlier this year.

The 25-year-old Nonkontwana, a former SA Schools and Junior Springbok, joined the Bulls after finishing his schooling at St.

Alban's College in Pretoria in 2014 and went on to represent the franchise at u.19, u.21, SuperSport Rugby Challenge, Currie Cup and SuperRugby level.

The big loose forward, who can also play in the second row, joined the Cheetahs in 2018, where he tasted European rugby in the Guinness PRO14 before returning to Loftus Versfeld for the 2020 SuperRugby season.

Meanwhile, the Bulls also confirmed that the former prop of the Lions, who later also played for Bath in England, Jacques van Rooyen, will report to Loftus Versfeld this week for fitness and medical tests.

He is currently back in Pretoria, having played in Japan last season since leaving Bath.

The 33-year-old Van Rooyen had a very successful professional career after being recruited by Johan Ackerman in 2013 out of the club rugby system in Pretoria at the age of 26 to join the Lions.

He eventually played in 130 games for the Lions, of which 66 were SuperRugby games.

This strong scrummer and excellent ball carrier has represented the Lions in three consecutive SuperRugby finals (2016-2018), while also being the union's Currie Cup captain in 2018.

Although Van Rooyen will probably be used as a backup for Springbok Lizo Qoboka, his experience and leadership qualities could be worth gold for the Bulls during the building process to Jake White's new team.

'Best is yet to come' – athlete

As a former Olympic Youth champion, Gezelle Magerman, made a promise to herself to never retire before she knows she has given it her all as 400m-hurdler.

"The last thing I want is to one day be haunted by the words 'what if'. The day I decide to put away my spikes for good, is the day I should know that I have lived my dream," the Tuks athlete said.

Her life has been a real rollercoaster ride over the last few years. More often than she would have wanted, Magerman ended up being disappointed. It would have been easy to quit. She has after all booked her place in South Africa's sports history when she won gold at the 2014 Youth Games in Nanjing.

Some believe Magerman has got the looks to make a name for herself as an international model. In 2015 she was one of the eight women being honoured by SA's Glamour Magazine.

But for now, it is athletics that excites and that gets her adrenaline pumping. To her, there is an absolute thrill to get close to running that perfect hurdles race.

The sports psychology student at the University of Pretoria firmly believes she can qualify for the Tokyo Olympic Games.

It will mean she has to improve by more than two seconds on the personal best time of 57.75s she had set in 2016. Magerman considers it doable.

Her confidence sprouts from training at Tuks with the former youth and junior 400m-hurdles champion Zeney van

der Walt as well as being coached by Maritza Coetzee.

"I don't see Zeney as a rival. She is a friend who shares the same goal. That is to be the best we can be. Since I started training with Zeney, I realised there is always room for improvement."

"That is exciting," she remarked.

According to Magerman, her coach (Coetzee) changed her whole perception as to what being a champion should be about.

"I used to be an egocentric as an athlete. Things needed to be about me, my success."

"Being that way inclined led to many an unnecessary tear being shed. It was my coach who taught me being self-centred is never going to make me happy."

"It is the best lesson I have ever been taught," she said.

Another important thing Magerman has learned is that if you do the hard work, there is no reason to doubt your abilities when settling in your blocks to race.

According to the Tuks athlete, she continuously needs to work on her endurance.

"I absolutely love the 400m-hurdles. The challenge of being so utterly focused on overcoming 10 obstacles running at speed excites me each time. The reality, however, is that you need to be as strong as you started out towards the latter stages of the race. It is something I battle with. But 'Coach' has got me working on it. I do feel I am getting stronger," she concluded.



Olympic medallist on track

Duné Coetzee has not lost a 200m-butterfly race in South Africa since 2017, but she is not fooled by her performances; the Tuks swimmer knows she needs to be faster.

That is why the 18-year-old decided to go to the University of Georgia after next year's Tokyo Olympic Games. She is not the first South African swimmer to go to Georgia. Other promising swimmers like Neil Versfeld, Sarah Poewe and Wendy Trott all did so. All three went on to become Olympians. Versfeld is now an assistant coach at the university.

According to Coetzee, the decision to go to the USA was not taken lightly.

"There were a lot of things I had

to take into consideration, but in the end, I realised the best for me would be to go to the USA," she remarked.

The Tuks swimmer also dreams of competing at the Games. The challenge to do so is to improve on her best time by at least two seconds. For that to become a reality, she needs to be pushed to her limits more often. Unfortunately winning the 200m-butterfly in South Africa has become a mere formality to Coetzee. She has been the South African senior and junior champion since 2017. As a way to ensure she does not get into a comfort zone, Coetzee resorted to testing herself against boys when training.

Her dedication has not gone unrewarded. Since 2017 she has improved her 200m-butterfly time

from 2:12.52 to 2:10.89.

The Olympic qualification standard is 2:08.43. Coetzee is aware of what needs to be done to gain that extra two seconds.

"I need to improve on my kick. It is of cardinal importance when competing in the butterfly. If I can improve on my endurance, it won't be a bad thing."

"Actually, to be genuinely competitive means you can never afford to rest on your laurels. There is always something in your technique that can improve," explained Coetzee who won a silver medal at the 2018 Youth Olympic Games.

The ultimate for the Tuks swimmer will be to share the Tokyo Olympic Games experience with her coach, Linda de Jager.

"I am not sure how many South African swimmers had gone to the Games being coached by a woman. I don't think many."

"That is why it will be unique. Linda taught me success and discipline go hand in hand. She is also the one that made me believe in my abilities," Coetzee commented.

For now, however, it is a case of first things first. Coetzee is in matric, and most of her focus is on ensuring she passes her exams at the end of the year. She admits that the Covid-19 crisis has complicated things somewhat.

"Luckily, the teachers at the Afrikaanse Hoër Meisieskool had been proactive. We already started on the matric syllabus last year. Up until the lockdown, we focused on the more challenging aspects of what needed to be learned. What helps is that the teachers are also prepared to help us on Saturdays or with extra classes at any time," Coetzee concluded.

Pro-teams resume training sessions

SA Rugby confirmed that the country's eight professional teams will start training again this week and that they can still be in action this year.

SA Rugby announced late last week that professional rugby teams would return to non-contact training from Monday.

The confirmation followed several weeks of preparation and consultation with government and all provincial unions to ensure compliance with regulation and to minimise the risk of Covid-19 infection.

Eight teams will resume training with a view to competing in domestic competitions that are being modelled by SA Rugby and member unions to be accommodated into the remainder of the year.

The eight teams are: the Bulls, Lions, Sharks, Stormers, Southern Kings, Cheetahs, Griquas and Pumas. Due to the economic impact of the pandemic on the sport, the remaining professional teams will remain in lockdown.

SA Rugby continued to work with all stakeholders on the prospects of a return to playing for the Springboks at some point this year.

"This is an important first step back to playing, and we have taken it carefully to ensure full compliance and having thoroughly interrogated the regulations with government," said SA Rugby CEO Jurie Roux.

Roux confirmed that contact training will not be permitted for the moment, but the players will be allowed back onto the field with a rugby ball and back into the gym, while

observing strict protocols in both areas. This comes as a great relief to the sport.

He said that all players and management teams were being screened before the return and that training venues had been prepared to conform to the new protocols.

Several competition formats with various start dates featuring eight teams had been modelled for the return to competitive play, as it was highly unlikely that air corridors would be opened to allow international travel.

Roux said the only teams expected to appear in 2020 were the eight professional teams and those that fielded u.21 teams. All other competitions as well as club rugby were cancelled.

"The risk associated with a mass return to train and play has been highlighted by government and the timelines and practicalities are such that it is unrealistic that there will be a general return to play this year," Roux remarked.

As a result of this arrangement the members of the CovCom (the standing committee of member unions and experts which has been managing rugby's response to the pandemic) opted to formally confirm that the only rugby to take place under their jurisdiction this year would feature the eight senior teams.

Roux added that schools' rugby did not fall under SA Rugby's jurisdiction and any decisions in that regard would be handled by the Department of Basic Education.
